Write a review of the book.</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u> Research how an avalanche is caused and write up what you have found out in your own words.</p>
<p><u>PSHE</u> Tell me about a way you have or could support people involved in a natural disaster</p>	<p><u>ICT</u> Use a computer or tablet to research the Hurricane which struck Southern Britain in 1987. How did it affect our local area?</p>	<p><u>ART</u> Sketch and label an erupting volcano.</p>
