Here we meet young Nat Field, a boy actor visiting London to perform at The Globe Theatre. Nat soon falls ill, and much to the amazement of the doctors looking after him, he has contracted the Bubonic Plague. As one young actor lies in isolation in Guy's Hospital, another wakes up in Elizabethan London and is drawn into rehearsals for <i>A Midsummer Night's</i> <i>Dream</i> alongside William Shakespeare himself and the two form a bond that can never be broken, even through time.
