Find some examples of modern arches to draw. You could try building your own arches.	<u>Science</u> Find out about some of the amazing inventions the Romans created. Describe your favourite inventions in a page titled "Roman Science and Technology".	<u>History</u> The Romans worshipped several different Gods. Create your own Roman God - what would they be responsible for? How would people worship you? Alternatively, create a fact file for one of the Roman Gods.
