<p>Design your own Mayan glyphs and give them a definition/meaning. Can you write out a sentence using your glyphs?</p>	<p>Find 5 items around your house.</p> <p>List what they are made from and why that material was chosen.</p> <p>E.g. A wooden spoon - made from wood as it does not conduct heat. This means that when you use it for cooking you won't burn yourself.</p>	<p>Research the history of chocolate, starting from the Mayan period, how it has changed throughout history and what it is like today. Present your findings as a poster.</p>
<p>Research what the Mayans ate. Using the information you find to create a Mayan Menu.</p>	<p>Place the events of the Mayans on a timeline using dates of special events.</p>	<p>Create a map of South America with a key showing the countries where the Mayan cities were located.</p>
