They know that Jesus died on a cross.</p>	<p>Excelling</p> <p>Using this knowledge and understanding pupils can raise relevant questions in response to their enquiry into the Christian concept of salvation. Pupils are able to discuss the idea of Jesus being extraordinary and can make connections to the 'Big Story'. They can explore how Jesus saved us.</p>
