Welcome Back!

Welcome!

We were delighted to welcome 4 new pupils and 1 new member of staff to Blackboys School on 8th March. Freya and Jacob joined us in Year 1, Delilah in Year 2 and Claudia in Year 5. They have all been given a warm welcome by the school community and we hope they have a productive time with us. We also welcomed Mrs Samantha Riley to the role of MDSA and Cover TA. Mrs Riley has already had a positive influence on lunchtimes and in Class 4 as she covers for the shielding Mrs Vance.

Lateral Flow Test

As communicated in our Covid-19 guidelines, school staff have all been taking a rapid response Lateral Flow Test twice a week as a further measure in keeping the school community safe. We have recorded 106 negative results and 0 positives so far. As an extra layer of reassurance, such tests are now available for families. Assessments

Next week all pupils in Years 1 to 6 will be sitting assessments in reading and mathematics. These assessments will be extremely useful for teachers to measure the children's attainment, particularly following this period of partial school closure. The assessments are called "Standardised Assessments" and allow us to compare our pupils' scores to a test group of over 1000 pupils nationally who have previously sat the same assessments. It will let us know which children are attaining in line with their particular year group. Most usefully, these assessments will allow teachers to pinpoint who may need extra support, who may need further extension and whether there are any areas of the curriculum the class as a whole need extra work on. Reviewing these assessments and planning our next steps will be a major part of our upcoming INSET Day on Thursday 1st April. I know Class teachers will be delighted to discuss outcomes with parents, so please get in touch.

Virtual Easter Service

Similar to our Harvest Festival and Christmas Carol Service, we will be having an online, virtual Easter Service on Wednesday 31st March at 9:15am. All classes are busy practising songs which we will play as part of the service, together with Easter readings and prayers. Children will stay in their classrooms and watch on their screens. Rev Chris will be leading the service and we would be thrilled if parents were able to attend via Zoom. Nearer the time we will distribute the Zoom joining code.
