Dear Parents / Carers,

It has been a productive fortnight at school since the previous newsletter.

As a school we have been visited by our School Improvement Partner, who was delighted with the purposeful learning in all classes, as well as the progress our younger pupils are making with their phonics and early reading. We have been thrilled with the start class 1, 2 and 3 have made with our new Monster Phonics scheme and it is having a real impact on children's ability to decode words and read more fluently. We have also had a big push on Maths calculations this term, including the re-launch of Times Table Rockstars. This online package has real benefit for our Key Stage 2 pupils. The quicker they can secure their times tables (and corresponding division facts) the better they will get on with other elements of the Maths curriculum. Other year groups are also welcome to attend with their parents, but in the past this has had a bigger effect on our oldest pupils. If there is something delicate that you need to discuss with classteachers, then naturally we understand that a child may not attend.
