Dear Parents / Carers,

With the weather warming up, we can be certain that Spring and Easter is on the way. There are reminders overleaf about our Easter Service on Wednesday 30th March.

May I take this opportunity to remind you that we have class assemblies coming up next week for Class 1 (on Wednesday 23rd March) and Class 2 (on Thursday 24th March). It was great to have so many parents/carers attend Class 3's assembly this week and I would really suggest parents/ carers and grandparents do their best to join us. Parents/carers and grandparents are welcome to join assembly any Thursday in the hall at 9:05am. Sometimes these assemblies are led by a class, sometimes by Rev Chris Lawrence and sometimes by a guest visitor. I think we've all got out the habit during the pandemic and it would be good to welcome some friendly faces in.

Last week we were visited by the Chairman of Wealden District Council, Cllr Ron Reed and our own Councillor Anne Newton. The children in Key Stage 2 had a Q & A session with them (with many excellent questions about road safety and speed limits in Blackboys!) The councillors presented awards in Gold Book assembly and then had a tour of the School. They were very positive about the pupils and the facilities we have here and were able to answer some of my questions about building work in the village and funding provided for schools. It was a very worthwhile visit.



We had more visitors yesterday (Thursday) when I proudly took local Headteachers around the school looking at the super work being done in the teaching of writing. This is something that we have, and continue to work hard on and the staff and pupils have responded brilliantly. It was great to showcase some of the children's excellent work.

Finally for this fortnight, I would like to praise a group of girls in year 5 who organised and ran a cake sale last week, raising £76.20 for our charity, Children's Respite Trust. Well done Connie, Lola and Millie. Our pupils' keenness to support other people is always awe-inspiring.
