Long hair should always be tied back using a hairband.		

Shoes should be black lace ups or Velcro fastenings, with low heels. They must be of traditional School style, not black trainers or plimsolls.

Boots are prohibited.

In Class 1, only book bags are used. These can be purchased from our uniform providers website. All children will require a book bag to carry letters/homework/reading books. Children will also need a drawstring PE Bag. Children in KS2 are invited to use a rucksack of their choice.

We ask that the following points are observed:

- Parents not to send pupils to school in unsuitable footwear (e.g. no fluorescent socks or shoes)
- For health, hygiene and developmental reasons, the wearing of trainers or boots all day is not permitted.
- Children must change for PE. This includes the removal of tights. Socks are therefore required in the PE bag to replace the tights.
- With the exception of a traditional watch or 'fitbit' being worn, children may not wear jewellery to school. Only small plain 'sleeper studs' may be worn with pierced ears. All earrings should be removed or covered with micropore tape during PE sessions. Watches will also be removed for PE lessons.
- For Safety reasons; long hair should be tied back **at all times**. Hair bands, if worn, must be plain, discrete and preferably of the school colour (green). School 'scrunchies' are available to purchase via our uniform provider. Excessively large or colorful hairbands are not permitted. The use of excessive hair gel to create elaborate hair styles is not permitted.
- Wearing of make-up or nail varnish is not permitted.

All items should be clearly marked with the pupil's name.
