Dear Parents / Carers

We have had another busy couple of weeks here at school with several sporting opportunities taking place for many of our KS2 children.

Children from Netball Club have been busy, with two teams of Year 3 and 4 children competing on 2 consecutive weeks at Uckfield College. We had mixed success, with one team coming 5th and the other coming joint 1st with Framfield and Harlands Schools. I really enjoyed seeing the children's confidence and skills improving as they played their matches.

Our Year 6 netball team visited Annan School last Thursday to play a 'friendly' match. The purpose of the game was to allow as many of the children from each school as possible to play in a match. We took 9 children and they showed off their skills brilliantly, winning the match 14-8 overall. We hope to invite Annan back to Blackboys over the coming weeks.

Also last week, Mrs Harper accompanied a group of swimmers to Uckfield Leisure Centre, where they took part in the annual swimming gala. This was a timed event with several heats for each event. As a team, the children came 5th, but we also had some individual 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings. A massive well done to

our children, who haven't yet had their school swimming lessons for this year!

In Assembly this morning, Mrs Sullivan introduced an exciting event that we are taking part in to help us celebrate World Book Day. Your child should have brought home a letter and sponsor form for a Readathon "Ready Steady Read!" that we are running in conjunction with Usborne Books. The letter explains how the Readathon works. We are asking children to get sponsorship from family and friends which will go towards the purchase of Usbourne Books for our school library. We would be thrilled if every child took part in this event.

After half term, we will be hosting Usbourne Books at an after school Book Fair. This will take place, immediately after school on Monday 27th February.

Next Tuesday 7th February is National Safer Internet day. Miss Mayhew and Miss Reis will be leading an assembly to remind children about how to stay safe when online. This would be a good time to remind parents about checking parental controls on your home broadband and on your child's phone, if they have one. This year's theme is "Want to talk about it? Making space for conversations about life online" so it is the perfect opportunity to start those conversations at home.

# Wrap Around Care

Currently, most days we are at capacity for After School Club and this has been the case for most of this term. Breakfast Club is also becoming increasingly popular and numbers nearing capacity.

Therefore we have to be strict on the 24 hours notice we require when trying to book in to the club. We will be unable to take same day bookings and there may be occasions when there will be no available space.

Please also remember should you not require a place at a wrap around care session to cancel your child's booking asap. This will allow us to offer the place to someone who needs it. We reserve the right to charge for bookings which aren't cancelled.

Our best advice is to book places as far in advance as possible. We would also like to remind parents that After School Club is primarily to support parents who need childcare for work or training. Wrap around care is not a lifestyle choice or a playdate provider.

#### Headlice

Currently, unfortunately it seems that we may have some unwelcome visitors in school, in the form of head lice. Please can you check your child's head regularly and be extra vigilant when brushing their hair. Can we also remind you that hair longer than shoulder length should be tied up, as this is also a good preventative for passing the lice on.
