We are asking that all children are dropped off directly to the church on this morning from 8.30am and the service will start at 9.00am prompt. Parents/Carers are of course welcome to join us for this annual celebratory service.

KS1 (Classes 1 and 2) will be returning to School via a coach (subsidised by the School). KS2 (Classes 3,4 and 5) will be taking their traditional hike back to School. A bin bag or reusable plastic shopping bag may also be packed for your child to sit on whilst enjoying their lunch.

#### **Medical Reminder**

One of our pupils is receiving medical treatment for cancer which puts them at risk, particularly if they are exposed to measles, chicken pox or shingles.

The best way to protect our pupil from measles is for children at school to be immunised against measles or excellent vigilance should an outbreak in a class occur. If your child is suspected of having measles, or mixes with children with measles, please let us know immediately.

Our pupil is also at risk from chicken pox and would need to start a medicine to hopefully prevent contracting the disease. If your child is suspected of having chicken pox you should again let us know immediately.

It is also important that you let us know if there is shingles in your household. Your child is not under any risk whatsoever from this situation, however the health and wellbeing of our pupil who is at risk does depend on the cooperation of our caring community, and we hope you will be able to help us.
