Reading for Pleasure	Word reading	Prosody	Comprehension
<p>Have a selection of books from the reading corner available on the table. These could be picture books or chapter books.</p> <p>The children have time to look at these together. They can read them, look at pictures, talk about them etc.</p> <p>The children choose one of these to take home at the end of the day as a "Reading for Pleasure" book. This is a book that they don't have to be able to read to their parents, it is to share.</p>	<p>Have 6-10 words that have the relevant phoneme in on flashcards and teach the children to read these words first.</p> <p>Look at the book and have a go at decoding the words. Try to teach the children to say the sounds in their heads to encourage fluency.</p> <p>Read the book to the children.</p>	<p>This is about modelling the fluency and intonation needed to read the book in a way that helps us to understand what we have read.</p> <p>Do this by using "My go, Our go, Your go". Read a sentence to the children, read it together as a choral read and then they read it by themselves.</p> <p>You can use the opportunity to introduce the different punctuation that they come across and how it changes the way we read parts.</p> <p>Look at sentences and make sure the children understand what a sentence is and that they need to pause at the end slightly.</p>	<p>Year 2 – this would be reading through the book and unpicking what different words mean and talking about what is happening. This isn't a question and answer session, if they aren't sure what something means, teach them!</p> <p>Year 1 and Reception – this might be going back to the vocabulary and practising that. It depends on the level of the book and what comprehension of it is needed.</p> <p>Make sure you have another read of the book.</p>
<p>Reading for Pleasure book goes home on a Monday and is returned the following Monday.</p>			<p>Phonics book goes home on a Friday and is returned on a Friday.</p>
