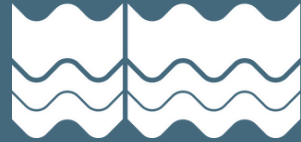

We provide advice and support that enables families/carers to develop their knowledge & understanding. We aim to help parents/carers develop their confidence around how to best to support their neurodiverse child whilst also building on their child's strengths, confidence, and self-esteem. The team is part of the wider CLASS service and focus on home based concerns.
