# IN YEAR ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS

In our Church of England School, we take strength in collaboration yet celebrate uniqueness. As a school we may be small, but we encourage children to be the best they can be, so they are ready to make their mark on the world. We welcome the child yet embrace the whole family. We celebrate our rural environment yet aspire to look beyond our boundaries. We strive for knowledge and gratefully accept opportunities that come our way to enable us to live life in all its fullness. We all take a pride in our School as we follow in Jesus' example.

At Blackboys Church of England Primary School our Christian ethos, vision and values underpin all we do; we are an inclusive school and strive to provide a firm foundation for pupils of all faiths and of no faith at all.

#### In Year Admissions/Applications:

In year admissions are those relating to children whose parents are seeking admission outside the normal timescale, which means after the first day of the first term of Reception.

Below sets out the process for seeking admission outside the normal timescale:

- Parents should contact the School directly with all 'in year admission' enquiries.
- The School will inform parents whether a place is available within the required year group. Unless the parent specifies otherwise, in year admissions will be assumed to be for the child's chronological age group.
- The School will arrange for the parents and child/children to visit the School.
- Parents complete the Application Form for admission. Parents should contact the School for the Application Form. For reference the Application Form is attached as Appendix One.
- Following receipt of the Application Form, the Headteacher will notify the
  parents of the outcome of their application in writing within 10 school days.
   Where an application is refused, the reason for refusal and information about
  the right of appeal will be stated in the letter.
- Where an applicant is offered a school place following an in year application (and the offer is accepted), arrangements will then be made to agree a start date for the child/children, and all necessary administration documentation completed. An application via East Sussex County Council's SAM (Schools Admission Module) portal (<a href="https://new.eastsussex.gov.uk/education-learning/schools/admissions/apply-in-year">https://new.eastsussex.gov.uk/education-learning/schools/admissions/apply-in-year</a>) must be made which will feed back into the Schools' registration system. At this stage, requests for documentation from previous Schools will be made.

Where the Admission Authority is dealing with multiple in year admissions and do not have sufficient places for every child who has applied for one, places will the allocated on the basis of the Over-subscription Criteria set out in Blackboys Church of England Primary School's Admissions Policy.

Should a place not be offered:

- Parents are able to join the School's waiting list.
- Parents have a right of appeal to an Independent Appeal Panel if they are refused a place. Parents should contact the School directly for information on the Appeals Process.
