## What is a preventative curriculum?

A **Preventative Curriculum** is a proactive and planned approach to safeguarding. It ensures that children are equipped with the knowledge, skills and values they need to stay safe, make informed decisions and navigate the wider world with confidence. Through carefully structured teaching and embedded opportunities across the curriculum, we aim to prepare pupils to recognise risk, respond appropriately and seek help when needed.

#### Intent:

At Blackboys Church of England Primary School, our preventative curriculum reflects our commitment to nurturing the whole child—spiritually, emotionally, socially, and intellectually. Rooted in our Christian values, we seek to foster resilience, empathy, self-respect and respect for others. Our aim is to create an environment where safeguarding is everyone's responsibility and is interwoven through everyday teaching and school life. We are intentional in ensuring pupils develop the tools to understand and manage the challenges they may face in the world today.

### How do we keep our curriculum relevant to pupils, staff and families at Blackboys?

We continuously reflect on the needs of our school community by:

- Listening to our pupils through pupil voice activities. We involve student leadership in discussions with multiple members of staff.
- Taking part in the My Health My School Survey to monitor trends and spot patterns
- Engaging with families through workshops, newsletters and conversations.
- Responding to local and national safeguarding trends.

Our curriculum is designed to evolve, ensuring it remains relevant, responsive and rooted in both statutory guidance and the lived experiences of our children.
