

Homework Menu - Term 4

Ask Miss Mayhew for a times tables sheet.	Inspired by the Mousehole Cat - write a diary entry from the point of view of an animal! Think about what they would do on a typical day and how they might describe things.	Ask Miss Mayhew for a sentence structure sheet.

2. These will also be worked on in class and at the end of the week the children will complete dictation sentences including these 10 words.
3. Dictation sentences will be stuck into the back of homework books each week in order to see progress and any words/spelling rules that may need to be worked on further.
